Likewise shall also the Son of man suffer of them. 13 Then the disciples understood that he spake unto them of John the Baptist.

**LUKE 1:15** For he shall be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink; and he shall be filled with the Holy Ghost, even from his mother's womb. 16 And many of the children of Israel shall he turn to the Lord their God. 17 And he shall go before him in the spirit and power of Elias, to **TURN THE HEARTS OF THE FATHERS TO THE CHILDREN**, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord.

MALACHI 4:5 Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD: 6 And he shall TURN THE HEART OF THE FATHERS TO THE CHILDREN, and the heart of the children to their fathers, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse.

In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,

**QUESTION:** His last vision of America being destroyed--do you think that is why America is not helping to defend Israel during the tribulation? According to Revelation Israel has no defender among the nations. America must have been removed. I have never witnessed a healing ministry before either. Should I be baptized to show obedience or is this a prerequisite to being saved and receiving the Holy Spirit?

**ANSWER:** ACTS 2:37 Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do? 38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. 39 For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call.

ACTS 2:41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls.

And they said unto him, We have not so much as heard whether there be any Holy Ghost.

EPHESIANS 1:11 In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will: 12 That we should be to the praise of his glory, who first trusted in Christ. 13






