L-51 So now, in speaking to the woman, if the Lord Jesus, the woman witnessing herself by her hand up, and me with my hands up, that we've never seen one another, don't know one another, nothing about it. But whatever it is, then to disbelieve that would be sin. Then you have not one excuse.
